### GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

Design suggestions for the building are minimal and include a restored wood and aluminum storefront, with 3/4 light commercial doors and larger display windows. The existing metal awning and infill is replaced with transom windows that admit daylight farther into the interior store space. The stucco on the side and rear of building is removed and the existing brick veneer is repainted to fit building's age and style.
